


Our achievements so far!

Around 50 new guests stay in the Joel Community Services Night Shelter every year. To accommodate some of those desperate street homeless people on the waiting list for our Night Shelter in 2015, we have built a new dormitory. We will be able to offer shelter, food and friendship to 14 single street homeless people at any one time and we can accommodate up to 70 guests a year!

With your support we can give them shelter and help them to get back on their feet....

Our Vision

To create a "designed for purpose" centre for homeless and vulnerable people in the heart of Kingston including a move-on option from the shelter for those who wish to remain within the Joel support network.



Our Plans: having set up our **Night Shelter**, in 2016 we are providing offices for Kingston Churches Action on Homelessness (KCAH) on site with all their expertise and professionalism. The final phase will be building a monastic style community with live-in support as a permanent move-on option for some Joel guests on the site at St Peter's Church.

Guests have access to...

- **Housing and Welfare Benefits Advice, and move-on options (KCAH)**
- **Training Courses: Life Skills, IT coaching, Job Club, English as a Second Language, 'Cook and Eat' Programme etc. (KCAH & Joel)**
- **Health checks and referrals (Joel & KCAH)**
- **Shelter, hospitality, friendship, support and spiritual nurture (Joel, KCAH, St Peter's).**

£20 would pay for one day's insurance and utilities in the Night Shelter.

£10 would pay for two meals for a guest in the Night Shelter.

£5 would pay for one volunteer to be fully trained to help man the shifts in the Night Shelter.

£15 a month over 5 years will contribute £1125, including gift aid, towards the project. If you are a UK tax payer we can reclaim 25p for each £1 donated so please complete the gift aid form below.
